(JODHPUR INDIA)

You're unlikely to find a more stunning setting for a music festival than the ancient Mehrangarh fort in Jodhpur, in the the Indian state of Rajasthan.

Built around 1460 and located on a hill 410 feet above the city, the massive fort (one of Indi's largest) includes an impressive museum and several palaces renowned for their intricate carvings and expansive courtyards.

At the base of this extraordinary monument is where you'll find the World Sacred Spirit Festival, which takes place over three days in mid-February founded in 2007, the event was formerly known as the World sufi festival. But it has Expanded its horizons over time to include a broad variety of sacred spiritual music from different parts of the world.

From melodious Lithuanian harp music and the traditional Italian folk songs of Sardinia to andalusian sufi songs of Morocco and Duduk (a type of clarinet) music from Armenia, music from North Africa, Eruope, and Asia will be featured. And of course through the local sounds of Rajasthan, India will be given their due time in the spotlight, from Qowwali devotional music to the droning double flute known as the satara.

It may not be the easiest festival for our western readers to get to but in terms of the mesmerizing music and the surrounding scenery, We can quarantee it'll be worth the trip. Her art express both raw emotions and the stringent denial of it: She carves out a place that is both deeply felt and introspective. She also avails herself of widely different styles, using colour – or the lack of it – perfectly matched to the narrative mood.

Your Black Friend is by far the shortest comic to make into this list, but there is nothing slight about it. Beneath its sardonic tone lies a truth that is urgent, sincere and deeply affecting.

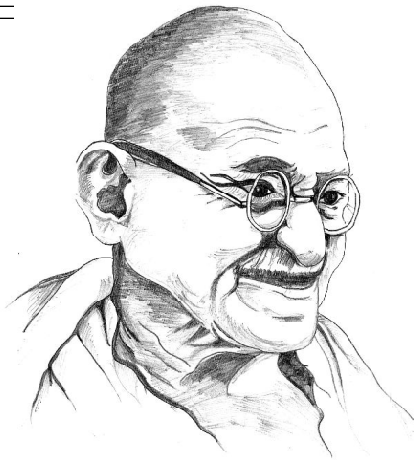

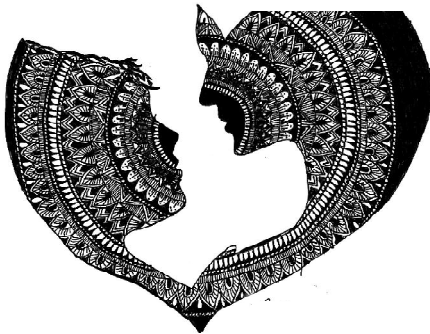

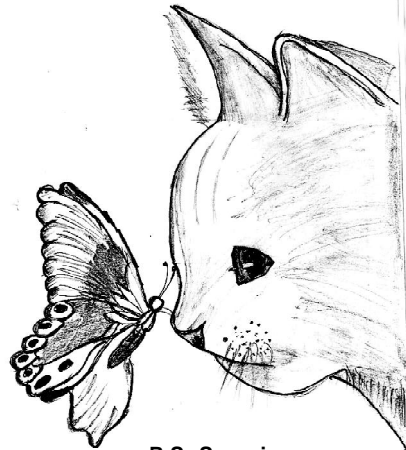
